Des Moines, Iowa – First Major Indoor Ag Show to be Held Since Spring

The second largest indoor U.S. farm show, presented by Farm Credit Services of America and AgDirect, will go on as planned December 8-10 in Lincoln, Nebraska. Spread across 9.2 acres, the 14th annual Nebraska Ag Expo will be the FIRST major indoor ag show to be held in the Midwest since Spring of 2020.

Safety is a top priority. “We have been working closely with the Lancaster Event Center and Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department to determine all the necessary precautions we must take to have a safe and successful expo,” said Tom Junge, Expo Director. The event will feature six easy-to-access entrances, wider aisles, additional lunch seating and extra staff to help keep facilities clean and sanitized.

“While a few companies can’t attend this year due to travel restrictions, many – including 82 NEW exhibitors and all major manufacturers – are excited about the opportunity to showcase their products and services to producers,” added Junge. “Agriculture production has never stopped. It keeps moving forward.”

The Nebraska Ag Expo continues to showcase only ag-related products. “Today, more than ever before, growers are hungry for knowledge and eager to adopt innovation and new technology,” said Junge. “We want to bring the latest ag technology, equipment and services – everything farmers and ranchers need to increase profits, lower input costs and improve technology – to Lincoln this December.”

Show hours run 8:30 am to 4:30 pm Tuesday and Wednesday, and 8:30 am to 3:00 pm Thursday. Admission is just \$5 or FREE with pre-registration at nebraskaagexpo.com.
